

ABOUT COOKIES ON OUR WEBSITE

Axess Logistics* (referred to as “we” in this policy) uses cookies on the website. In summary, we use cookies for the following purposes

- [For analysis and development of the website – if you have given your consent](#)
- [To show you relevant marketing from us on other websites and platforms – if you have given your consent](#)
- [So that you can use our portal](#)
- [For the website’s functionality and to remember your choices](#)

You can find more detailed information about our use of cookies in the website’s cookie banner. If you click “Show details”, you can, for example, see the names of the cookies we use, which services we use, and how long each cookie is used for. You can always find this information by clicking “cookie settings” in the bottom-left corner of our website.

What are cookies?

By “cookies”, we mean all cookies, pixels and similar tracking technologies that provide us with information about your device and store information on your device. If you’d like to know more about cookies and the legislation that governs how cookies may be used, you can visit [the Swedish Post and Telecom Authority](#). Your personal data

When you use cookies on the website, we will collect certain information that constitutes personal data. To protect your privacy, we have taken steps to avoid identifying you when you use our website. For example, your IP address is encrypted so that, in practice, it is impossible for us to track who you are. When we process data that can be directly or indirectly linked to you as an individual, we explain this in our [privacy policy](#).

Third-party services and third-party cookies

We mainly use standard “HTTP cookies”, but we also use more advanced pixel cookies and third-party cookies from various marketing service providers. Google may use the information collected for its own purposes, but our other providers do not use the information for their own purposes and act only in line with our instructions. In the information below and in our cookie banner, we have, as far as possible, included links to information on how third parties use cookies.

Cookies we use with your consent

STATISTICS AND ANALYSIS – For analysing and improving the website

We use temporary and persistent cookies from Google to help us **analyse how the website is used** and to **improve the website**.

By using cookies on the website, we receive information about your IP-address in encrypted form, as well as information from your device during your visit to the website (e.g. how many people visit different pages on the website, how long our visitors stay on the website, which parts of our website are used and which device is used). In addition, we also use information that Google already has about you.

MARKETING – To show you relevant marketing

We use cookies to show you relevant marketing when you visit other websites and platforms, and to measure how effective our marketing is. We do this using Google's marketing services.

These tools mean you may see search results and advertising banners from us based on analysis of how you've used our website, as well as other information our suppliers hold about you (so-called "profiling").

If you block/delete these cookies, the marketing you see will be less relevant.

Your consent is voluntary

The cookies we use for these purposes aren't strictly necessary for the website to work, so we need your consent to use cookies when you visit the site. We will therefore only use this type of cookie if you choose to give your consent first.

If you block cookies, we have less data to monitor how the website is used and fewer opportunities to improve the website. If you block this type of cookie, you'll be asked again next time you use our website whether you want to accept them.

Essential cookies

We use cookies that are necessary for the website and portal to function properly, and to remember your choices. Without this type of cookie, you can't use all parts of our website. If you choose to block this type of cookie, it may mean that the website doesn't work as well as it should.

STRICTLY NECESSARY – So you can use our portal

To **check whether you're signed in** and to **keep track of your session** we use temporary cookies. These cookies are deleted when you close your web browser.

In addition, we use a cookie to make sure that anything you add to your basket stays there until you return to the basket during your visit.

These cookies are essential for the portal to work properly, so your consent isn't required for their use.

STRICTLY NECESSARY – For the website's functionality and to remember your choices

We use temporary cookies and session cookies to ensure the website works properly and to remember your preferences. The cookies described below will be used when you visit our website. These cookies are necessary to provide a service that you have explicitly requested, i.e. they are required for the website's functionality and to remember your choices, so your consent is not needed to place these cookies in your browser.

- To **ensure the website works purely from a technical** perspective, cookies are used. One cookie is used to keep track of your session by creating a random ID for your visit. Another cookie is used to improve the website's loading speed. In addition, cookies are used from our website provider Partrap and from Microsoft.
- We use cookies to **protect our website** from unauthorised publishing of content or similar third-party attacks. These types of cookies are necessary for the website to run smoothly.
- To **make sure our forms work technically** we use cookies from [Wufoo](#).
- To **check whether you've accepted the cookies** that require consent, we use cookies from Cookie-Script. Cookie-Script provides our cookie banner, and the cookies used in connection with it are intended to ensure that we only use analytics cookies (see above) if you have actually agreed to this in our cookie banner. This permanent cookie is essential for the website's functionality, so your consent is not required for the use of this cookie.

Avoid cookies

You can block certain types of cookies by adjusting your browser settings so that it automatically refuses to store cookies, or notifies you each time a website asks to save a cookie. You can also use your browser to review which cookies have been stored and delete them. See your browser's help pages for more information.
