

ABOUT COOKIE-LIKE TECHNOLOGY IN OUR NEWSLETTERS

Axess Logistics ("we") uses cookie-like technology in our newsletters.

We use this technology to check that our newsletters are delivered and to analyse our mailouts. If you receive our newsletters, this means we collect information confirming delivery, how you open our newsletters and what you click on, your IP-address in encrypted form, other device information and your e-mail address.

What is cookie-like technology?

By cookie-like technology we mean cookies, pixels and similar tracking tools that provide us with information about your device and store information on your device. Your personal data

By using cookie-like technology in our newsletters we will collect certain information that constitutes personal data. To protect your privacy, we have put measures in place to avoid identifying you when you open or click anything in our newsletters. For example, your IP-address is encrypted so that, in practice, it is virtually impossible for us to track who you are. When we process data that can be directly or indirectly linked to you as an individual, we explain this in our [Integrity policy](#).

Avoiding cookie-like technology

Without the cookie-like technology that we have described above you cannot receive our newsletters because we would then have less reliable data to monitor how the newsletters are used and fewer opportunities to improve them.
