

Information from Axess Logistics to our customers regarding production and transport capacity in December 2024

Dear Customer,

At Axess Logistics, we would like to inform you about our production and transport planning for December 2024, considering the public holidays this year and the resulting reduced capacity. During week 52, we will only have two working days, and during week 1, there will be three working days. In a period of high demand for our services, it is essential that we work together to ensure that all aspects of our operations run efficiently.

Production capacity PDI/Terminal: In the last week of December and the first week of January, we will have limited production. This reduction in capacity may affect our delivery times, and we want to be transparent with you about this situation. Our production is scheduled to return to normal levels in week 2 of January 2025, and we are doing our utmost to manage this transition as smoothly as possible.

Transport capacity: Transport capacity during week 52 is estimated to be at 30%, while in week 1, we will have a capacity of 50%. This means we can expect limited transport capacity during these weeks, so we recommend planning your logistics well in advance. To ensure that we can meet your needs, it is important that you place your orders as early as possible.

The Importance of early planning: We want to emphasize the importance of submitting your vehicle orders and requests as early as possible. Early planning and ordering are crucial for us to meet your needs and avoid potential delivery delays. The sooner we have your orders, the better we can manage capacity and ensure everything runs smoothly as planned. We appreciate your cooperation and understanding during this period.
